Robert A. King, MD, is Professor of Child Psychiatry and Medical Director, Tourette/OCD Clinic at the Yale Child Study Center, Yale University School of Medicine, New Haven CT. In addition to being deeply involved in the clinical care of children and adults with these disorders, he has been an investigator in a wide range of research projects sponsored by NIH and the Tourette Syndrome Association in areas such as psychopharmacological treatment, auto-immune mechanisms (the so-called "PANDAS" hypothesis), cognitive behavioral treatments, genetics, and clinical phenomenology of these disorders and their impact on families, and has been the author of numerous research articles and chapters concerning these topics.

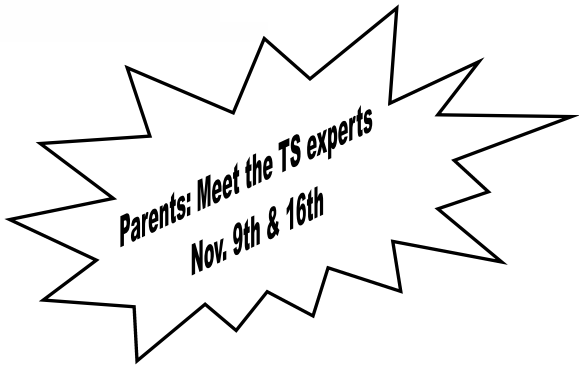
Nov 16: Bergen Regional Medical Center, 2:30pm to 4:00pm with Dr. Cathy Budman

Dr. Budman is an international authority on Tourette Syndrome and its comorbid conditions. She is Director of the Movement Disorders Program in Psychiatry at North Shore University and Associate Professor of Psychiatry and Neurology at NYU School of Medicine. Dr. Budman serves on the National Medical Advisory Board for the Tourette Syndrome Association. She serves as a consultant to the New Jersey Center for the Treatment of Tourette Syndrome. Dr. Budman's clinical research has focused on the treatment of TS and its associated disorders, with an emphasis on the phenomenology and treatment of explosive outbursts in TS. She is also engaged in ongoing studies exploring the genetics and neurobiology of TS. Dr. Budman has authored and co-authored numerous publications and educational materials on TS and related disorders.
